CONDITION OW3 WATER SUPPLY:

To adequately service the development and to maintain water supply pressure in the locality, the developer shall undertake the following works:-

- Construct a 150 mm main along Windsor Circle and Buckingham Street connecting the existing mains in each street (approximate length of pipe 350 metres).
- Construct a 150 mm main linking the water main in Haly Street to the extended water main in Buckingham Street (Nb. This will also require the negotiation of a water supply easement through an adjacent allotment).

Notwithstanding the above requirements, if the developer substantiates to Council's satisfaction that a lesser standard of water supply is required than that provided by the above works then the water main connecting Haly Street to Buckingham Street shall not be required. To satisfy this exemption, the developer should supply to Council details of required pressure and flow rates at particular positions within the site, to meet relevant fire fighting and Aged Care Facility standards. Council will then reassess the minimum infrastructure works required and advise the developer accordingly.

CONDITION OW5 ROADS:

The following clause to be inserted into the second paragraph after the works "*Bank Guarantee*": or a letter of intent prepared by solicitors on behalf of the developer and acceptable to Council.
